- Learn greetings, numbers to 10, colours and days of the week.

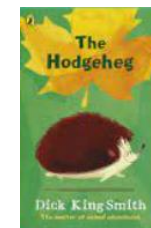
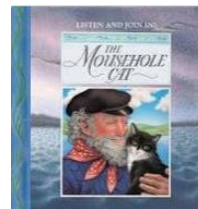
