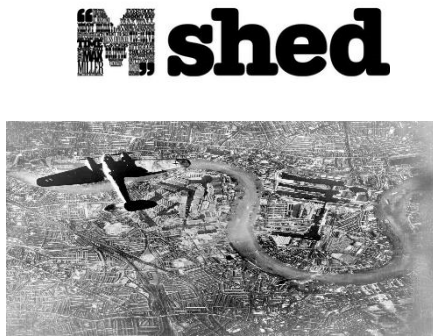


As historians we will be exploring...

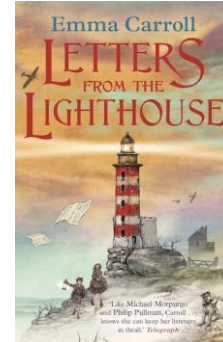
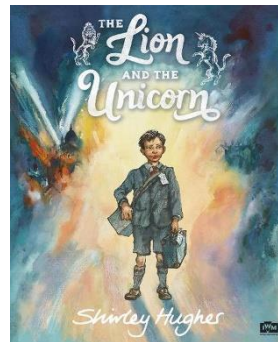
