Dear Parents and Carers,

Clifton College Activity Centre trip – Weds 8th May 2019

Our Y3 and Y5 classes have been invited to attend Clifton College Activity Centre on **Weds 8th May** to take part in a range of activities across a whole day visit. Activities include archery, a sensory woodland walk, trebuchet and low ropes.

The classes will be leaving school at approx. 9am and returning to school in time for the end of the school day.

The cost of the day and transport is free for all children. Children will need to take a packed lunch and plenty of drinks for the day. If you would like the school to provide this, please choose that option on ParentPay as soon as you can - the deadline for this is Tuesday 1st May.

All children will need to wear their PE kit, plus a long-sleeved sweatshirt, jogging/track suit bottoms and trainers. A waterproof jacket should also be brought in case of rain. As all of these activities are outdoor (some in woods/trees) we recommend that older clothing/footwear is worn in case they are damaged.

As the activity day is within Bristol, it is covered under the permission slip you signed at the beginning of the year.

We hope that your child will enjoy the chance to take part in some unique activities.
