Dear Children, Parents and Carers,

On **Wednesday 5th December** we will have a science lesson teaching the children about irreversible changes, followed by our 'bread experiment' to make the dough for our experimental versions of our bread designs. All children will need to bring the additional ingredients they are using to flavour the bread.

We are going to be looking at different types of breads, evaluating these for flavour, appearance, texture, purpose and value (both nutritional and monetary). We are also going to be making some of our own bread in school this term.

I am writing to ask that you send in £1.50 in the next week to cover the cost of the ingredients etc so that the work can go ahead. Also, everyone should bring an apron of some description on **Wednesday 5th December** (a clean shirt or a tea towel tucked into skirt/trousers will be fine).
